- Need for a greater diversity of affordable activities
- Need for a Recreation Center
- Need to expand & improve Education

**Opportunities**

- Find common ground by identifying shared values & priorities. Acknowledge differences respectfully
- Develop funding sources for facilities & services
- Create a Recreation District
- Develop Continuing Education

**Part II. Expand on Opportunities**

- Find common ground in the community by taking advantage of the comprehensive plan process & participating in this process through online public surveys & public meetings.
  - Develop funding sources at the state level by lobbying, community action groups, attending committee meetings, contacting elected officials, and working through the political process. Grant writers and others to explore public & private funding sources.
  - Opportunity to create a county wide recreation vision/master plan & have support to maintain & operate those facilities & activities. Need a community action group to create the recreation district.
  - Recreation Center in Pioneer Park, Victor as stated in Victor’s Master Plan
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- Promote idea of opening satellite campus utilizing existing facilities, use Education Network in school district
