BALLOT MEASURES

SPECIAL ROAD AND BRIDGE LEVY ELECTION

Shall the Board of County Commissioners of Teton County Idaho be authorized to levy an override levy pursuant to Idaho Code § 63-802(3) and Idaho Code § 40-801, in the amount of up to \$1,400,000 per year for a period of two years, commencing with the fiscal year beginning Oct. 1, 2024, for the purpose of improving County infrastructure maintained by the Road and Bridge Departments of Teton County, and of the cities of Victor, Driggs, and Tetonia, all as provided in the Resolution adopted by the Board of County Commissioners of Teton County on March 21, 2024.

This levy shall result in a tax of \$24 per \$100,000 of taxable assessed value, per year, based on current conditions. The proposed levy replaces an existing levy that will expire on September 30, 2024 and that currently costs \$22 per \$100,000 of taxable assessed value. If the proposed levy is approved, the tax per \$100,000 of taxable assessed value is expected to increase the tax by \$2 per \$100,000 of taxable assessed value.
