

NOTICE TO CONTROL NOXIOUS WEEDS

Idaho Statute | Title 22 | Agriculture and Horticulture Chapter 24 Noxious Weeds 22-2407. Landowner and Citizen Duties

1) It shall be the duty and responsibility of all landowners to control noxious weeds on their land and property, in accordance with this chapter and with rules and regulations promulgated by the director.

2) The cost of controlling noxious weeds shall be the obligation of the landowner.

3) Noxious weed control must be for prevention, eradication or restoration.

However, areas may be modified from the eradication requirement after the director has determined them to be unreasonable for short-term eradication and has designated the area as a special management zone.

4) The landowner shall reimburse the county control authority for work done because of failure to comply with a five (5) day notice, as outlined in section 22-2405, Idaho Code.

5) If an article is infested with noxious weeds, it shall not be moved from designated premises until it is treated in accordance with the applicable regulations, or in accordance with the written permission of a control authority.
