Defendant Pleads Guilty to Delivery of Methamphetamine

Today, defendant Tracy Heredia Lopez pleaded guilty to Delivery of Methamphetamine, a felony offense under Idaho Code § 37-2732(a), as alleged in the Amended Criminal Information dated May 2, 2023. The charge carries a maximum penalty of life in prison and/or a \$25,000 fine.

Ms. Heredia Lopez was arrested on August 10, 2022 for the sale of methamphetamine out of her then-residence located at 89 Beryl Avenue in Victor, Idaho. The Teton County Sheriff's Office verified that the substance was methamphetamine through testing by the Idaho State Police Forensics Laboratory.

Ms. Heredia Lopez pleaded guilty pursuant to a plea agreement entered with the State. Per the terms of that agreement, Ms. Heredia Lopez pleaded guilty to one count of Delivery of Methamphetamine, a felony offense under Idaho Code § 37-2732(a). She also admitted three pretrial release violations relating to drug and alcohol testing during pendency of the case, and agreed to pay restitution and court costs, as ordered by the Court. The imposition of jail time will be at the Court's discretion.

District Judge Alan Stevens has set the case for sentencing at 11:00 am on August 1, 2023.
